# RVCC, SAINT PETER'S UNIVERSITY SIGN TUITION AGREEMENT

Raritan Valley Community College (RVCC) and Saint Peter's University have signed an agreement that offers tuition breaks to RVCC graduates who enroll in the Jersey City-based university.

According to the new agreement, which was signed April 10 at the College's Branchburg Campus, RVCC graduates who are accepted to and matriculate at Saint Peter's University will be able to pay reduced tuition. The annual tuition these students will pay will be equal to the highest New Jersey state college tuition rate. To qualify for the reduced tuition rate, students must be enrolled in a full-time baccalaureate degree program at the University.

"The new agreement with Saint Peter's University offers a unique opportunity for RVCC graduates who want to continue their education close to home, giving them the option to attend a private university for the same price as a public institution," said James B. Ventantonio, RVCC Interim President.

"We are proud to become a transfer partner with Raritan Valley Community College to streamline the process for students who would like to continue their education at New Jersey's only Jesuit University," said Eugene J. Cornacchia, Ph.D., President of Saint Peter's University. "We look forward to welcoming Raritan Valley students to our campus."

The agreement will apply to RVCC graduates enrolled in any 120-credit bachelor's degree program in the College of Arts and Sciences/School of Business Administration, School of Education, or School of Professional and Continuing Education at Saint Peter's University. It is limited to one baccalaureate degree. All fees and housing costs will be charged at Saint Peter's regular rate.
