



## Student ID Options

### 1. Physical Student ID Card

Receive a wallet-sized student ID card by visiting the Student Enrollment Center.

#### How to Get Your Student ID:

- Visit the Student Enrollment Center in person, **Monday and Thursday 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.**
- Be prepared to have your photo taken.
- Your card will be printed on the spot—typically within 10 minutes.

#### Photo Requirements:

- **Not Allowed:** Sunglasses (unless medically necessary), hats or hoods (except religious headwear such as a hijab), or any facial coverings that obscure your appearance.
- **Suggested Attire:** A plain, solid-colored top with no writing or printed designs.

**Note:** These same guidelines apply if you are submitting a photo for a Virtual Student ID. Avoid selfies, and ensure your photo is taken in front of a plain white or cream background.

### 2. Virtual Student ID via 360u App

The 360u app serves as your mobile Virtual Student ID. It can be downloaded from:

- Google Play Store (Android)
- Apple App Store (iOS)

#### 360u App Setup Instructions:

##### Download & Install:

1. Open the Google Play Store or Apple App Store.
2. Search for **360u** (by TouchNet).
3. Tap Install.

##### Log In & Access Your ID:

1. Open the 360u app.
2. Type "Rar" in the search bar.
3. Select Raritan Valley Community College from the list.
4. Tap Log In.
5. You'll be redirected to the TouchNet Authorization Service.
6. Tap OK and sign in using your student credentials:  
**Gnumber@stu.raritanval.edu and RV password**
7. Review and agree to the End User Privacy Notice.
8. Tap the middle bottom icon (mini portrait image) to access your Virtual Student ID.
