- Ten (10) points will be awarded to applicants with prior healthcare employment experience. A letter from your employer on company letterhead confirming employment must be attached.
- Five (5) points will be awarded to applicants with prior healthcare volunteer experience.
 A letter from your supervisor on company letterhead confirming employment must be attached.
- Honorably Discharged Military Veterans or will be awarded two (2) additional points.
 Proof of honorable discharge must be attached.
- Applicants with a Bachelor's degree by the application deadline will be awarded two (2) additional points. An unofficial transcript from the degree-granting institution must be attached.
- Applicants who have completed MLTC 100 with a "B" or better by the application deadline will be awarded one (1) additional quality point.
