Caldwell College Transfer Agreement

College: Raritan Valley Community College
Type of Agreement: Dual Admissions & Articulation
Date: November 13, 2006

Dual Degree: Dual Admission agreements are specialized transfer agreements. The agreement offers students who have been denied admission to Caldwell College guaranteed admission and transfer of credits to Caldwell College after completion of all Raritan Valley Community College degree requirements. The agreement is also available to other students before they have obtained 30 credits from Raritan Valley Community College and who wish to transfer to Caldwell College after completion of all Raritan Valley Community College degree requirements.

The agreement provides for:

- Receipt by Raritan Valley Community College of the names of applicants rejected by Caldwell College.
- Receipt by Caldwell College of the names and contact information of applicants to Raritan Valley Community College who are interested in dual admissions to Caldwell College.
- Raritan Valley Community College will publicize this agreement to prospective and current students in promotional literature and website with a link to Caldwell College.
- Raritan Valley Community College will provide special arrangements for Caldwell College recruiters/academic advisors to visit and meet with prospective and current dual admissions students.
- Automatic acceptance to Caldwell College with junior status to students who have completed an Associate Degree at Raritan Valley Community College
- Scholarship awards ranging from \$5,000 to \$16,000 to Raritan Valley Community College students admitted to Caldwell College with GPA's ranging from 2.8 to 4.0 and a waiver of application fee.
- Students inducted into PTK can receive additional scholarship up to \$1,000. NJ STARS II students who maintain a 3.0 GPA can receive scholarships that range from \$8,000 to full tuition.
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Articulation: An Articulation Agreement is a written agreement between two colleges or universities that outlines how a course(s) or academic program will transfer from one to the other. This in essence is a course by course agreement, which is for the purpose of maximizing the number of credits students can transfer. Each articulation agreement

specifies how the coursework taken at Raritan Valley Community College applies to the baccalaureate degree program at the four-year institution.

This agreement provides for:

- Automatic acceptance to Caldwell College with junior status to students who have completed an Associate Degree at Raritan Valley Community College with at least a 2.5 GPA and a 2.75 for education majors.
- Agreement of the General Education Foundation Transfer Principle with the understanding that grades lower than a 'C' can not be transferred.
- Course by course equivalency as agreed upon by both institutions.

Caldwell College and Raritan Valley Community College


Caldwell College will accept a maximum of 75 applicable and approved credits from students of Raritan Valley Community College who have completed an appropriate AS and AAS program and completed their degree. Credits earned in basic skills courses or developmental courses and course grades less than 'C' are not transferable.


Students who have an Associate Degree and a grade point average of 2.5 or greater and 2.75 when applying as an Education major will be guaranteed admission to Caldwell College.

To earn a bachelor's degree from Caldwell College, students must complete a minimum of 120 credits. The 120 credits include major requirements as listed in the Caldwell College Undergraduate Catalog and include 57 core curriculum credits. Credits transferred under this articulation agreement may be used to satisfy core curriculum requirements and up to one half of major program requirements.

Caldwell College embraces the "full faith in credit principle". Caldwell College is a signatory to the General Education Foundation Transfer Principles in 2006 by the NJ Presidents Council and fully participates in NJ Transfer.

Raritan Valley Community College students who wish to transfer to Caldwell College should complete an application for transfer admission and maintain contact with Caldwell College through the Raritan Valley Community College Admission and Advisement Office.
