°The ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS for Nursing Students) is the required nursing entrance test for applying to the Generic RN program at RVCC. ## °ATI TEAS covers Reading, Math, Science, and English. RVCC only accepts ATI TEAS results that include all 4 parts of the test and ATI TEAS (TEAS for Nursing Students) tests taken from 8/31/2017 through the present time, in order to apply for the Fall 2019 Generic RN program at RVCC.

°To apply for the Fall 2019 Generic RN program at RVCC, all students are required to take the latest version of the ATI TEAS. ATI TEAS Version V will no longer be used by the test vendor- ATI, LLC as of 8/31/2016. RVCC's Generic RN program WILL NOT use ATI TEAS Version V testing results towards Fall 2019 clinical applications. All students will need to take the updated ATI TEAS, with all 4 parts of the test.
