Drop-In Tutoring & How It Works

Signing In

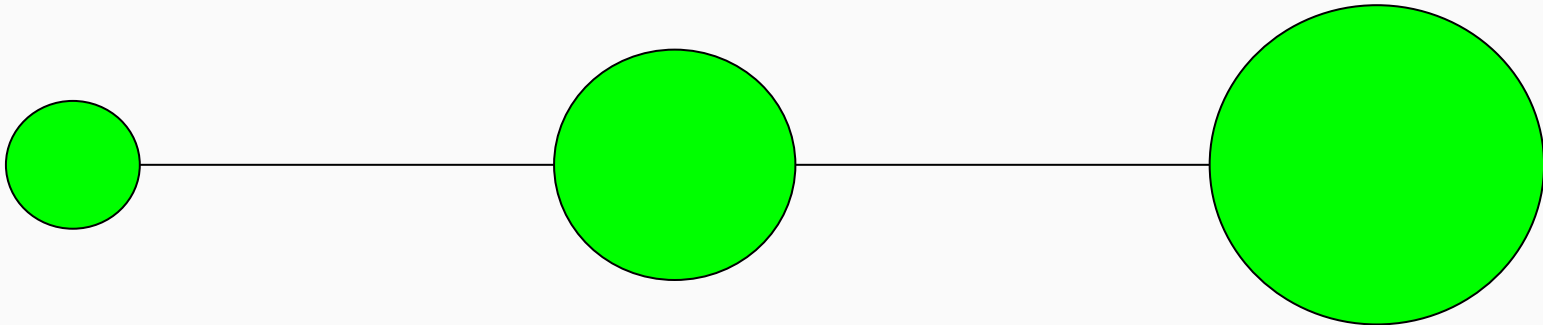
Students need their **G#** to sign in and should know the **subject** and/or tutor they'd like to work with.

What To Bring

Students should bring a copy of the **assignment** + instructions, their textbook + **notes**, and relevant **questions** regarding the material.

Tutoring Sessions

Each session is **30 minutes** long. Students must wait **30 minutes** between sessions, and use that time to **practice** with the material.

- **Tutor assisted study groups** up to 1 hour
- **Free calculator rentals** for class/tests/quizzes to all students with a G#
- **Textbooks** may be borrowed for the duration of a students stay at the ASC, but **cannot leave** for any reason.
- **Computers + printing** for student use, including a Macbook Pro station.
