Confronting Genocide: Never Again Presented by *The Choices Program* at Brown University



The Raritan Valley Community College Institute for Holocaust and Genocide Studies invites you to an interactive workshop by Mimi Stephens, Professional Development Director for *Choices Program*. Mimi will present *Confronting Genocide: Never Again*, a curriculum unit produced by the *Choices Program* at Brown University. We will discuss the Genocide Convention and consider the challenges of defining "genocide." Participants will apply the standards of the Genocide Convention to five historical cases: The Trail of Tears, Colonial Congo, the Ukrainian Famine, Tibet, and the Conquest of the Desert in Argentina.

The curriculum guide also includes student readings and videos on: The Holocaust, Armenian, Rwanda, Sudanese, Bosnian and Cambodian Genocides. We will consider the benefits and limitations of using personal stories to learn about historical events. During this hands-on workshop, we will ask: How can we memorialize a genocide? What is the purpose of memorials? What is the concept of historical memory?
